- Check your HOPE GPA – create an account. Use your legal name, and not a nickname. KMHS must have your SSN on file to check your HOPE GPA and to receive HOPE.

- HOPE Scholarship and Zell Miller Scholarship eligibility requirements, course rigor list
- College planning, scholarship searching, career exploration

Explore College Options and Career Interests

- September, February, and spring breaks are great times to visit colleges without missing school.
- Attend college fairs and info sessions both fall and spring semester. Check for colleges visiting KMHS in Naviance check the counseling website for upcoming college fairs.
- Review the “Choosing a College Handout”
- Check college admission requirements – including course requirements (fine arts, foreign language credits required, etc.), SAT/ACT requirements, etc.
